

1 Postdoctoral Researcher (100%, E13 TV-L, 2 ½ years) - Statistics in Contemporary China

The [Chair for Sinology with a focus on the Intellectual and Cultural History of China](#) — Institute for Near Eastern and East Asian Languages and Civilizations — at FAU Erlangen-Nuremberg (Germany) invites applications for a position of a Postdoctoral Researcher (f/m/d) with an interest in the global/transregional entanglements or the sociology of quantification in contemporary China, in particular statistics or predictive sciences.

The position is part of the interdisciplinary project “[Quantification from Europe to East-Asia](#)” funded by the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation (2021–2026). This project focusses on political and historical epistemologies of statistical production and forecasting practices and their global/transregional circulation.

Together with the other project members the applicant will conduct research on the social, political and cultural conditions of quantification in China in a global/transregional perspective and contribute to the following activities:

- Coordination of research activities in the project (research seminar, fellow invitations)
- support for the organization of conferences and project related publications
- collaboration in preparing applications for third-party funding

The successful candidate is expected to have the following qualifications:

- a PhD in Chinese studies, statistics, sociology or related disciplines,
- strong interest in the role of quantification and prediction in science and society,
- preferably research experience in China, Hong Kong and/or Taiwan,
- experience in interdisciplinary and international research contexts,
- excellent knowledge of working languages English and Chinese.

The position is to be filled by **April 1st 2023** or later. Yearly budget will be provided to support archival research and international conference participation.
